We are pleased to invite 1 or 2 young people from your Centre to join the 8th Goose Network Camp Staff Seminar, which is taking place from Thursday 5th to Monday 9th April 2012 at B.-P. Park, Bassano Romano (Rome), Italy (www.bppark.it).

Objectives of the Seminar

- To enable the young staff of the Goose Network's Scout / Guide Centres to create new partnerships and network between fellow Scouts / Guides who are equally dedicated to the development of their Centre
- To promote the exchange of voluntary staff members between Centres (Goose Exchange)
- To promote future seminars focussing on topics of common interest
- To share ideas on different activities and methods used at each Centre, and in doing so improve the quality of future projects
- To focus on personal development (skills, knowledge and values)

Beneficiaries of the Seminar

The participants should be (voluntary) staff members, ideally aged between 18 and 30, and from a Goose Network Scout / Guide Centre. They should demonstrate an interest in both environmental issues, and in making improvements to the environmental sustainability of their Scout / Guide Centre.

Seminar Programme

The seminar will consist of both theoretical and practical sessions. Topics will include 'My Centre, My Country', 'Market of Possibilities', how to be a Goose Network Camp Staff member, nature conservation and environmental work, intercultural communication, and local Scouting in an environmental context.

Finances

The seminar fee is €200 (maximum) per person and includes accommodation, tourist tax, full board and VAT. Unless you are planning to arrive directly to B.-P. Park (70 km. north of Rome) the Planning Team is trying to organize transfers from Rome (main airports and railways stations) to B. P. Park within the above fee: for this purpose please specify your travel plans in the Application form.

Please ensure that the applications are sent no later than Friday 17th February 2012. Once we have received your application(s), we will send all relevant information to both you and the participants. You will be informed about the programme schedule and any further details as the plans for the event progress.
