

Goose Exchange

Goal:

The main goal of exchanging camp staff volunteers between our centres is a personal and hopefully a long lasting contact between the exchanging persons and to achieve personal experience, working together and participate as a staff member at the summer camps or weekends/weeks with scouts during the year.

What is in it for the centres?

- The hosting centre is responsible for your pick-up and accommodations. In return they get a staff member for at least a weekend and the most a week. The staff member has to try different functions to get inspiration for his or hers own centre.
- The sending centre is responsible for your sending and travel costs (arrange with your centre how much of it you are to pay yourself) In return they get a motivated and experienced staff member home afterwards who are ready to develop the centre.

How can you take part in this exchange?

 - Other items, ex. Time wishes
