Beneficiaries of the Seminar

The participants are to be (voluntary) staff members between 18 and 30 from member goose network scout / guide centres. They demonstrate an interest in environmental issues and show potential to make changes in order to improve the environmental sustainability of their Scout / Guide Centre.

Seminar Programme

The seminar will comprise of both theoretical and practical sessions held indoors and outdoors. Topics will include 'My Centre My Country', nature conservation and environmental work, how to be a Goose Network Camp Staff member, intercultural communication, 'Market of Possibilities' and local scouting in an environmental context.

Finances

- The Seminar Fee is 150 EURO (maximum) per person including accommodation, tourist tax, full board and VAT.
- An additional 70 EURO per person is requested which will go for travelling expenses to those participants who have far to travel.

Please ensure applications are sent no later than 28 February 2009. After we have received the applications, we will send all relevant information directly to the participants and a copy to you. You will be informed about programme details and other things as the planning progresses.
